HLTAID003 Provide First Aid

Course is open for anyone working in any kind of industry responsible to provide safe workplace to meet the obligations in case of accident or injury e.g. persons working in hospitality, construction, healthcare, childcare, job sites, offices, security and for those who want to gain knowledge and learn these lifesaving skills.

Prerequisites

There are no prerequisite for this unit, however training packages describes the candidates must have Foundation Skills (language, literacy and numeracy) that are essential to perform oral communication in order to make an accurate verbal report to emergency response services and workplace supervisor.

Course outcome

The HLTAID003 Provide First Aid unit of competency is derived from the HLT Health Training Package and is accepted by WorkCover as an industry standard first aid qualification.

On successful completion of this training program a Statement of Attainment in HLTAID003 Provide First Aid will be issued to the participants. Students will receive their Statement of Attainment within five working days from the date of completion of the course through express post.

Australian Resuscitation Council (ARC) guidelines indicate that a (Cardiopulmonary resuscitation) CPR qualification should be renewed every 12 months and that a First Aid qualification should be renewed every 3 years.

Course Duration and Delivery Method

The course requires self-study and completion of workbook (Almost 4 – 7 hours); and 1 (one) day (Eight Hours) classroom based practical training, theory and practical assessment.

The competencies to be achieved during the training program

- Assess an emergency situation
- Maintain the airways, breathing and circulation of an unconscious casualty
- Administer first aid for minor wounds and apply infection control procedure
- Manage a casualty with external bleeding
- Manage a casualty suffering from shock
- Manage a casualty suffering near drowning
- Manage a casualty suffering from extremes of temperature
- Administer first aid for burns and electric shock
- Administer first aid for eye and soft tissue injuries
- Administer first aid for venomous bites & stings and allergic reactions
- Administer first aid for spinal injuries and fracture
- Manage a casualty for chest/ head/ abdominal injuries
- Determine the principles for the assessment and movement of the sick and injured & first aid recording requirements
- Understand the legal and social responsibilities of the first aider
- Determine first aid facilities and training requirements
- Learn correct procedure for performing CPR and use of Automated External Defibrillator (AED)

Assessments and Course Procedure

Submit expression of interest to the advertised course by contacting through our website, email or on phone

- Be provided with the Students handbook, a copy of the Course Flyer and the Enrolment form.
- Be enrolled in the course, through completion of the Enrolment form
- Get confirmed your enrolment through email receipt or phone call by our staff.
- Be issued with the learning materials for the course (first aid manual and First aid workbook)
- Participants need to use the work book in conjunction with manual and required to answer each question in the corresponding section of the workbook.
- Completed workbook need to be returned to prior or on the day to your attendance at the practical course components. This is mandatory if the workbook is not completed prior to the course the participant will not be able to attend the classroom training session.
- During classroom training all the candidates will be assessed for skills in performing first aid procedures through demonstration and with questioning to confirm essential knowledge.
- For assessment purposes, demonstration of skills in CPR procedures requires using a model of the human body (resuscitation manikin) in line with Australian Resuscitation Council Guidelines.

Pathways

Participants seeking further training options to enhance their skill set such as HLTAID007 Provide advanced resuscitation or may undertake a range of qualifications from the HLT Health Training Package.
